HOW DO I ACCESS MX MERCHANT 6?

DO I NEED A SPECIAL USERNAME AND PASSWORD?

If you already have login credentials for MX Merchant 4 and/or 5 the same will work for 6.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE AN ACCOUNT, HOW DO I GET ONE?

If you don't have login credentials you will need to create them in MXA.

WHO WILL TRAIN MY MERCHANTS AND MY AGENTS?

MX Merchant 6 is designed to be extremely user-friendly so training should not be necessary. However, there is also support documentation within the application to help users understand and answer questions.

HOW WILL WE MAKE MONEY ON MX MERCHANT 6?

By marking up your buy rate as you do with MX Merchant 4 and MX Merchant 5.

ARE THERE EDUCATIONAL VIDEOS TO HELP ME LEARN TO USE MX MERCHANT 6?

HOW IS MX MERCHANT 6 BASE PACKAGE BILLED TO MERCHANTS?

MX Merchant 6 is billed to Merchants the same way MX Merchant 4 and MX Merchant 5 are billed today - which is through the processor's monthly merchant statement.

WHAT ARE THE BUY RATES FOR MX MERCHANT 6 BASE PACKAGE?

WHO DO I TELL THE MERCHANT TO CALL FOR SUPPORT?

HOW DO MY CURRENT MERCHANTS SWITCH OVER TO MX[™] MERCHANT 6?

Merchants will use the same login credentials they have for 4 and 5 to login to MX Merchant 6.

WHAT IF A MERCHANT STILL WANTS TO USE MX™ MERCHANT 4 AND/OR 5?

MX Merchant 6 is backwards compatible, meaning customers and payments entered into MX Merchant 6 will also be shown in MX Merchant 4 and MX Merchant 5.

DOES MY MERCHANT NEED A NEW LOGIN FOR MX MERCHANT 6?

The same username and password combinations that work in MX Merchant 4 and 5 also work in MX Merchant 6.

WILL MX MERCHANT 6 WORK ON TSYS?

Yes. MX Merchant 6 will work for TSYS merchants that are boarded in MX ISO/Agent.

DOES MX MERCHANT WORK FOR VIMAS MERCHANTS?

No, not at this time.
